



PUBLIC WORKSHOP #1

Your Input Matters!

You are invited to a Public Workshop regarding compatibility planning around Fort Drum.

The Development Authority of the North Country (DANC), in cooperation with Fort Drum, Jefferson County, Lewis County, St. Lawrence County, the communities within the counties, and other agencies and organizations in the region, is preparing a Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) to address planning around Fort Drum. The primary objective of the JLUS is to reduce current and potential conflicts between Fort Drum and surrounding communities while accommodating new growth and economic development, sustaining economic vitality, protecting public health and safety, and sustaining the operational missions of Fort Drum.

The JLUS will assess 25 compatibility factors, identify existing and potential issues, and develop strategies to address the issues. The compatibility factors include, but are not limited to:

- Biological Resources
- Coordination and Communication
- Energy Development
- Housing Availability
- Land Use
- Noise
- Safety Zones
- Vertical Obstructions

In order to develop a study and

recommendations that are responsive to local needs, input from the community is essential!

DANC is hosting a set of two public workshops. The material presented will be the same, but there will be two geographic locations to provide a broader opportunity for attendance. These workshops will include a presentation with an overview of what a JLUS is, how the public can get involved, and how the process will provide communities information and tools to assist with future land use decisions around Fort Drum. An overview of the operations that occur at Fort Drum will also be presented. The meeting will conclude with an interactive audience participation exercise where attendees can give input on compatibility issues they would like to see addressed in the JLUS.
