5.1 Hauler Meeting Wrap-Up

I would like to thank those haulers that took time out of their busy schedules to attend the hauler meeting that was held at the Authority's Materials Management Facility on March 21st. I will briefly summarize what was discussed at the meeting as a reference for your future use.

5.2 Customer Service Items

Very soon the new scale facility will be operational. This will change traffic patterns and how your drivers interface with the scale operator. The new scales are located at the main facility. It is the preference of the Authority to move toward paperless transactions. We're in the process of upgrading software and hardware and will keep you apprised of progress. 5.3 Facility Requirements

What is expected from the users of the Materials Management Facility is clearly outlined in the *Solid Waste Disposal Permit Requirements, Permit Application and Landfill Site Rules*. This document can be found on the Authority website, the link is attached at the bottom of this section. It is recommended that you familiarize yourself with these requirements. Specific items where deficiencies have been noted include the usage of cell phones on site, nonfunctioning CB radios, incomplete PPE while outside the vehicle at the working face, detarping prior to arrival at the working face and drivers exiting their vehicle at the scale queuing area.

5.4 Recycling Compliance

As you are aware, recycling is mandated by law in NYS. All recyclables are required to be separated from solid waste and therefore cannot be disposed of in loads delivered to the Materials Management Facility. As a result, a recycling surcharge will be added to the tip fee of any load of material that is determined to be contaminated with excessive quantities of recyclables. This determination will be made after the load is inspected by a minimum of two supervisory Authority staff. Loads found to be in violation will be subject to the tip fee being doubled.
