Section 1. The Board of Trustees of the Village of Hermon hereby accepts the applicability of the State Fire Prevention Code for the Village of Hermon to become effective on the 30th day of June, 1983, in accordance with the provisions of Section 392 of The Executive Law, or as soon thereafter as it is filed with the State of New York.

Section 2. In accordance with Section 381 of The Executive Law, and amendments thereto, the Village of Hermon will not enforce the State Fire Prevention Code on or after January 1, 1984.

Section 3. The Village Clerk is hereby instructed to file a certified copy of this Local Law in the principal office of the State Building Code Council, Division of Housing and Community Renewal at Two World Trade Center, New York, New York 10047.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect upon its being duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State and in the office of the State Comptroller.
